

Outcomes for students in receipt of the Pupil Premium at St. Martin's School 2017/18

In the 2017/18 academic year, there were 279 students in Year 11, 34 of whom received the Pupil Premium at the time of sitting their GCSEs. This makes the PP population 12% of the cohort.

Students achieving a grade 4 in both English and maths:

Non Pupil Premium: 82%

Pupil Premium: 50%

National Average of Pupil Premium: 43%

Not achieving a grade 4 in English or maths 26.5% (9 students)	Achieving a grade 4 in maths but not English. 2.9% (1 student)
Achieving a grade 4 in English but not maths 20.6% (7 students)	Achieving a grade 4 in both English and maths. 50% (17 students)

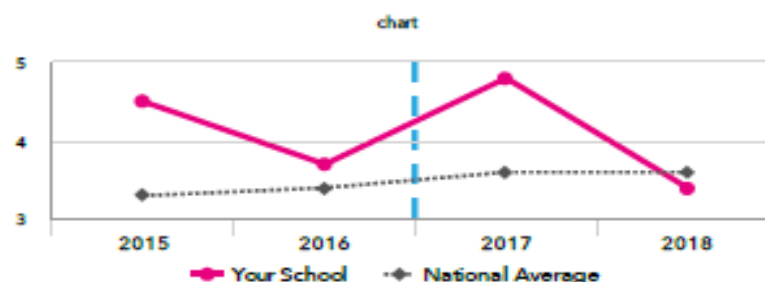

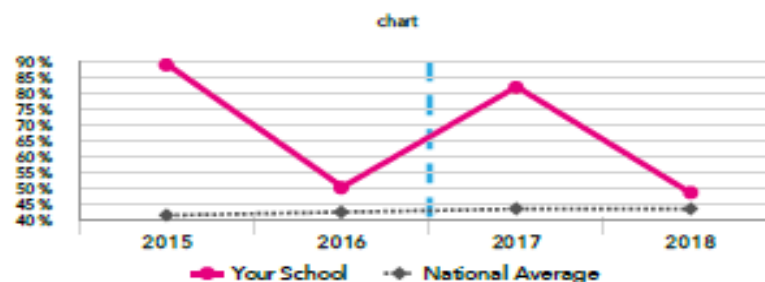
