

Biology – Year 11 into 12 Transition Work

Parts 1 and 3 to be handed in during your **SECOND** Biology lesson in September

1. Complete the calculations (separate document)
2. Organise for September a ring-bound file and 15 file dividers, labelled 1-15. Exercise books and guidance as to what will be filed will be given to you in September
3. Produce a written report on the following:
 - Choose a native British species from the list below. Tell us why this species is endangered, why we should save this species from extinction, and the mechanisms in place to do this (with reference to *in situ* and *ex situ* conservation and any local, national or international agreements).
 - Species list -Scottish wildcat, pine marten, hazel dormouse, water vole, hedgehog, red squirrel
 - You should include a bibliography (reference sources – books, internet sites, radio or television programmes used etc)
 - For guidance your report should be 2 – 3 sides of A4 in length.
 - Images may be included – but they must be included for a reason, NOT just to make your report look good.
