Headteacher's Comment:

It has been another exciting and enriching week for our pupils, with opportunities to inspire ambition, celebrate success and encourage creativity.

On Tuesday, a small group of Year 12 pupils visited Emmanuel College, University of Cambridge. The visit provided a valuable insight into Oxbridge and Russell Group pathways, addressing common myths and clearly explaining the application process and college system. A guided tour led by current undergraduates helped pupils to see these opportunities as both accessible and achievable.

Thursday, we held our Year 9 Options Evening, which was extremely successful. It was very positive to see so many parents attending and engaging with the process as pupils begin to consider their next steps.

We are extremely proud of our Trampoline teams who competed in the Zonal Finals of the British Championships in Cardiff. Despite injury preventing the U19 team from scoring collectively, Molly T (Year 10) won an outstanding GOLD medal as an individual. Our U14 team — Seren, Isla and Phoebe (Year 9) — secured TEAM GOLD once again, with Seren also qualifying for the solo finals. We will be looking forward to them competing in the National Finals in Derby on 14 March.

Year 12 Visit to Emmanuel College

On Tuesday, a small group of our Year 12 pupils had the privilege of visiting Emmanuel College at the University of Cambridge.

The visit provided an inspiring insight into the opportunities available at Oxbridge and Russell Group universities. Common myths were addressed, and the application process, including an explanation of the college system, was clearly outlined, helping pupils to see these pathways as both accessible and achievable. Pupils then enjoyed a guided tour of the college led by two enthusiastic current undergraduates, who spoke openly about their own application journeys and their experiences of studying at Cambridge.

Following a delicious lunch, pupils took part in a workshop focused on personal statements. This session offered valuable early preparation for Year 12 pupils, emphasising the importance of super-curricular activities and academic curiosity beyond the classroom.

We were delighted to be invited back and are excited to welcome the Emmanuel College Outreach Team to St Martin's in March, when we will host a local schools' information evening for parents and pupils. Our aim is always to encourage pupils to dream big, and we continue to aspire for more of our pupils to achieve Oxbridge offers each year.






Upper school production, *We Will Rock You*
