The National Crime Agency's CEOP Education programme website domain name has now changed from <u>www.thinkuknow.co.uk</u> to <u>www.ceopeducation.co.uk</u>. Their previous 'Think U Know' brand has been retired and the programme is now referred to as CEOP Education. The previous name was given when the Home Office campaign was first established and linked to a key question of "think you know who you're talking to online?" This messaging is now outdated and not in line with the programme's values and position on anti-victim blaming language. There is a dedicated Parent & Carer section for support for those who are concerned about their child's behaviour online, reporting an incident to CEOP or for further information & advice on keeping your child safe.
