### WaterBear Visit

Our GCSE, BTEC and A Level Music pupils were treated to a Careers talk from Chris Allan, a professional drummer who has performed at the big UK festivals, has worked with famous faces like Sir Brian May of Queen, and has recently recorded at Abbey Road Studios. He was visiting on behalf of WaterBear, a higher education college in Brighton and Sheffield, that offers Bachelor degrees and equivalents in Music-oriented subjects.

The talk revolved around the multitude of careers in the UK Music industry, from management to synchronisation,

to technical production and royalty collection.

Chris spoke about the need to diversify your skillset to thrive in the modern Music industry, and the importance of professional workplace skills like reliability, organisation and the ability to network with other professionals. Pupils responded well to the talk, many with a fresh perspective on the Music industry and the plethora of job roles that go in to making something like Taylor Swift's \$100m tour. The talk was particularly rewarding for Rio Francis in Year 11, who volunteered to share his ambitions with our 120 Music pupils - literally rewarded with a £10 Amazon voucher for his willingness to participate. The free pens, badges, stickers and tote bags were also popular with our pupils. Thanks to Chris and the WaterBear team, along with our Music staff for helping bring this together.
