Re: GCSE and A-level Contingency Day

The Joint Council of Qualifications (JCQ) have declared a contingency date of Wednesday 29 June 2022 for the Summer 2022 examinations; this is the last date that any exam can take place on should it have to be moved from its original date/time.

The JCQ states: "The designation of a 'contingency day' within the common examination timetable is in the event of national or local disruption to examinations. It is part of the awarding bodies' contingency planning for examinations".

Students are advised to stay available until Wednesday 29 June 2022 should an awarding body need to invoke its contingency plan.
