I would like to offer your son or daughter the opportunity to attend the performances of 'Pericles' and 'School for Scandal', performed by the Royal Shakespeare Company on **Wednesday 4 September and Thursday 5 of September 2024.**

- 19.30 pm ETS arrive at St Martins School

There may be times during the trip when students are given free time. They should not go off on their own but should remain in small groups at all times. Staff will issue a contact number should any student become separated.

I will be leading the trip accompanied by Mrs Wilkinson who also teaches on the course.
