Re: Jack Petchey's Individual Grants for Volunteering

Jack Petchey's Individual Grants for Volunteering is now OPEN for applications from young people wishing to apply for funding to volunteer on a project, either in the UK or abroad.

Any young person can now apply for a grant of up to £400 to help them volunteer on a range of projects including in conservation, education, the medical field and more!

What is the Individual Grant for Volunteering?

This programme is for young people who want to take part in a volunteering project! Whether the project is in the UK or abroad, Jack Petchey can help with a one-off grant of up to £400 per person. Jack Petchey will fund up to 50% of the cost of the young person's project and no more than £400 per person, and it is expected that the young person will be committed to fundraising the rest of the balance.

Who can apply?

Any young person aged 11-25 living in London or Essex can apply. Young people interested should ensure that their project includes voluntary work.

When should they apply?

2-9 months before the project starts.
