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WAG (Working at Grade): This is entered by the subject teacher. The number is based on GCSE grades (9-1). A "W" shows they are working towards a Grade 1. Subgrades of -, =, + are used to show where on the range the student is currently.

The key shows what the colours represent. A student that is making the required progress towards their final GCSE target will be showing **Yellow** and/or **Orange**. **Red** shows a subject that needs development (multiple reds across reports would be a concern). **Blue** and **Purple** are only seen in a small % of students and shows they are excelling and likely to achieve above their GCSE grade if they continue working at their current rate.
