Bletchley Park Trip

Recently, St Martin's Year 10 and 12 went on a computer science trip to Bletchley Park, home of the most advanced codebreaking unit of the Second World War.

After a guided tour and summary of the history of the site, students learned about many of the famous thinkers who contributed to breaking (what the Germans had thought) was an unbreakable code. One particular man stood out: Alan Turing. He figured out the complex workings of the Enigma machine – the coding machine that transmitted German messages. Turing is widely regarded as the Father of Artificial Intelligence. In fact, to start breaking a coded message, there are 159,000,000,000,000,000,000 possibilities of initial settings to test, meaning that if we checked a different setting every second nonstop, you would take 5.0419 x 10¹² years - a figure so large, that our calculators cannot even handle the numbers. This amount of time is longer than the world's existence, which illustrates the vast task of breaking the code!
