I have recently been selected to represent England U19s in their upcoming camp in Spain where we will play friendlies against Germany and Switzerland. This is my fourth time being called up to the U19s although I'm currently only U18 so playing up a year. I also recently travelled to Portugal where I played against Norway, I got an assist and scored a penalty.

I have been representing England from U14s all the way through to U19s. I made my debut for the U19s against Slovenia in the U19 Euro qualifiers and scored my first two international goals. I have been on loan at Ipswich women's first team gaining minutes and experience in a first team environment; I won player of the month in October, my first full month with the squad.

Just this week I had my senior debut for Arsenal beating Brighton 4-0!

I've also just signed a three year boot/sponsorship deal with Puma.



I've been trampolining since I was 8. From Year 9 to Year 11 I trained up to five days a week and this saw me progress to compete nationally across the country. During this time, I was scouted and invited to a performance pathway camp with the top coaches in the country, and was pushed to my maximum potential off the trampoline, during key exercises and strengthening movements.



So far, I have competed at big event arenas in London, for example, the Lee Valley VeloPark and the Copperbox, where I won the National Final in November 2022. I started racing at the age of eight and since then I have been hooked on the sport. I have focused on road racing where I race with the Lee Valley Junior Cycling Team. I'll also be racing regularly in the British Cycling National Road Series. In July I'm looking forward to competing, with my team, in a week long stage race in the Junior Tour of Ireland.
