We were delighted this week to welcome back to St Martin's Collingwood Learning for their performance of '*Dead End*'.

The production has been funded by Essex Highways and is a TIE performance designed to help young pre-driver students in upper school engage with the topic of Road Safety from the perspective of both driver and passenger and explore causes and consequences of Road Traffic Incidents.

The performance, including a workshop, allowed students to consider the choices, decisions and consequences of the characters' actions and incorporated the risks some young drivers take, such as drink/drug driving, being distracted and the fatal consequences this can cause.
