All items are safety checked and all data erased from the hard drives before being passed onto local schools.

The day they were delivered the CEO of the Charity, Mike Tabard and our tech team were on board to take the latest delivery of equipment. Every Child Online have given St Martin's 3 donations so far; comprising of 30 large workstations and monitors, 50 small desktop computers and monitors plus laptops. These computers will be used to replace the current ones in the school library and the laptops will be going to our Exams Team to support students who need a device in their exams.

### **Year 8 Successes**


Congratulations to Amy Hart in Year 8 who was successful in her submission to the Royal Academy Young Artist's Summer Show.
