Resilience Voyage

We were fortunate this week to have the opportunity for some of our students in Years 8,9, 10 and 11 to visit the Resilience Voyage – "drugs bus", which was funded by the Youth Service.

The aim of this exercise was to empower students to build resilience in their decision making and make informed decisions as to how they can avoid getting involved in anti-social behaviour including drug misuse.

As part of the immersive workshop, they visited a 'drug den' on the top floor of the bus and took part in an escape activity in a replica prison cell, to consider where the consequences of some of the choices young people make can end. The feedback from students has been very positive and we will consider using this workshop for future Enhancement days.
