Holocaust Education Trust visit

On Monday and Tuesday this week the Holocaust Education Trust (HET) came in to run a 2 hour pilot workshop with GCSE Historians. The sessions built upon students' subject knowledge on Jewish persecution under the Nazis that evolved into the Holocaust where 6 million Jews and other undesirables were systematically murdered in the Second World War. The HET used technology to share the story of a survivor, Manfred Goldberg. Students were able to log onto a website and ask Manfred questions about his life. The software enabled students to feel like they were having a one to one conversation with him on camera. Later, students used VR headsets to engage in an immersive 360 degree experience at a number of key sites, including his childhood home. We intend to continue to work with the HET and build these sessions into our History curriculum.
