Year 11 Report – Pre-Public Exam Results

Please be advised your child should have received a hard copy of their report today, which is now available to view on the St Martin's website.

Select Insight reports from the main menu, which will then take you to the Insight login where you can view the report.

This report contains the examination grades your child achieved in the recent pre-public GCSE examinations (PPEs). The grades do not include a weighting for components such as coursework but provide a measure of current attainment in the examination component of all their GCSE subjects. The PPE grades on this report are followed by a +, = or – sign. If a student's result is at the lower end of a Grade 4, for example, they will be awarded a 4-; if they secured a Grade 4, they will be awarded a 4=; if the result is at the higher end of Grade 4, they will be awarded a 4+.

The report also shows current projected grades, given by your child's teachers. The projected grades are based upon performance in the pre-public examinations, grades they have achieved for coursework or practical components and performance in classwork and homework. The grades are a reliable measure of what your child could achieve in their final GCSE examinations based on their overall current attainment.

Please take time to discuss the year 11 assembly with your child. We have tried to replicate the experience that the students will experience on Thursday 25 August 2022 when the final GCSE grades are released.

It is obviously a crucial time in your child's education as we reach the final months of year 11 and we sincerely hope they continue to work extremely hard over the next few vital months.

We look forward to the results in August and your child achieving grades that reflect their undoubted potential.
