On their return to school, students will be informed that study spaces in the sixth form will be monitored more carefully, and they should use these to their advantage in order to successfully prepare themselves for the summer examinations. The common room will remain a communal area to meet and work in groups. The computer room will be for those that are working but do not need a silent space. Anyone not working in this room will be asked to move into the common room. The library remains a silent working space and students should aim to use some of their private study time working in this space in order to effectively consolidate the work they have completed in lesson time.
