Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Residential revision trip to Danbury Outdoor Centre

I am pleased to confirm that your son or daughter has gained a place on the Danbury revision trip.

Alongside the revision, students will be completing outdoor activities. As a result, please ensure that students have suitable footwear and clothing for these activities as it may be muddy. Students should also bring stationery; all revision materials will be provided.

We will be meeting at Essex Outdoors Danbury, Well Lane, Danbury, CM3 4AB at 8.30am on Tuesday 5 April; please make sure students have eaten a good breakfast prior to arrival. All meals from lunchtime on the first day through to dinner on the second day will be provided, plus access to drinks throughout.

Students are required to be collected from the venue at 6.45pm on Wednesday 6 April.

If there are any medical or dietary requirements not already stated on the consent form can you please pass these on as soon as possible. A duvet and pillow are supplied but students will need to bring their own pillowcase, duvet cover and bottom sheet; alternatively, a sleeping bag with pillowcase would suffice.

Recommended equipment and clothing:

- Nightwear
- Towels
- Trousers and leggings for activities (at least three pairs)
- Old or used trainers for activities
- Fleece, hoodie or sweatshirt
- T-shirts and sports tops
- Waterproof jacket and coat
- Sun cream and hat
- Plastic bag for wet clothes
- Toiletries
- Bedding (as stated formerly)

I will be speaking to students next week regarding the logistics of the trip but I would like to stress that the emphasis of the trip is to undertake high quality revision which will last for the majority of the day and evening excluding meals and activities. In the unlikely event that students cause disruption to a revision session they will be removed from the session and a decision will be made as to whether they remain on the residential. I am sure this will be a productive and effective two days, from which the students will benefit greatly.
