Looking to go to University?

More and more students are applying to universities with BTECs which is a clear sign that institutions have recognised the value of a BTEC qualification.

In 2016, nearly **1in4** students who got into a university did so with a BTEC**.

If you are aiming to continue into Higher Education you can be confident that your BTEC Level 3 National provides the UCAS points you need for your university application just like A levels and AS levels do.

You might also choose to progress to a BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC), which is equivalent to the 1st year of university, or a Higher National Diploma (HND), which is equivalent to the 1st and 2nd year of university, before progressing to the final year of a full degree.
