Dear Parents and Carers,

Following on from yesterday's email, I can now update you on the school finish times for the remainder of this week. The weather forecast is stating that the temperature tomorrow (Thursday) will drop slightly and therefore the school will remain open all day with pupils finishing at the usual time of 3.05pm. Unfortunately, the weather will rise again on Friday and we have therefore taken the decision to close the school at 1pm on this day.

We have already made a number of adjustments to support pupils and staff during the warmer weather. These include re-rooming lessons where possible to cooler classrooms, allowing pupils to wear PE kit or normal school uniform, and making blazers optional. Staff will also continue to support pupils in staying hydrated throughout the day.

Thursday 25th June - pupils should attend school as normal and will be dismissed at the usual time of 3.05pm.

Friday 26th June – pupils should attend school as normal and will be dismissed at 1pm. Lunch will be available at break time for all pupils.

Our contracted bus providers are aware of the early closure on Friday and have confirmed that they can accommodate the revised finish time. Pupils who travel using NIBS public transport will remain subject to the usual public transport timings. We will ensure that provision is in place for any pupils who need to stay on site until their usual transport arrangements are available.

We also have Year 6 Induction taking place on Thursday and Friday. We have made some adjustments to support this during the warmer weather, and separate communication will be sent to Year 6 families.
