Over the summer you should produce an album of photographs that document your journey over the summer through your camera. You can use any type of photography and should try and show a range of styles (think Instagram, stop-motion animation, digital, analogue, or macro photography). You should also aim to visit at least one photography gallery or exhibition. Document your gallery visit through ticket stubs, notes about the photographers or artists you see and any photographs you take during your visit to the gallery or postcards you collect.

'Document your summer in 20 photographs':

You should document a narrative in only 20 photographs that explain what you did over the summer holidays. Think about interesting composition, angles, light, repetition, colour, pattern, abstraction, shadow, texture, perspective, scale and mood. Use www.studentartguide.com as a resource to help you, as well as the starting points below:

- Photographs that represent 'atmosphere' e.g. Landscapes, weather, holiday scenery, etc
- Photographs that represent 'home' e.g. Personal belongings, rooms in your house, infrastructure, etc
- Photographs that represent 'personality' e.g. Fashion statements, emotions, controversial signage, etc
- Photographs that represent 'textures' e.g. Surfaces, fabrics, patterns, etc
- Photographs that represent 'events' e.g. Portraits, signage, colours, etc
