Re: Year 12 and Year 13 Trip to London Zoo

As your son or daughter is studying Biology at A-Level they would benefit greatly from attending an educational trip to London Zoo. The date of this visit is Friday 8 March 2019 where they will be attending a lecture that will cover two topics of their Biology A-Level. The school will not be organising any transport to and from the Zoo so students will need to make their own way there and back. The closest train station is Camden Town. The address of London Zoo is: Regent's Park, London, NW1 4RY.

Students may dress casually and will need to bring their own lunch or ensure they have enough money to buy it at the Zoo.

- Arrive at London Zoo main entrance by 10.30am
- Tour around the Zoo
- Lectures 11.30am
- Tour around the Zoo
- Students will be free to depart the Zoo from 4.00pm

An emergency number will be issued to the students if they need to contact staff. Students must not leave the Zoo before 4.00pm and will need to sign out with one of the staff members before they leave.

The trip will cost £14.00 per student (plus the cost of return train travel to London Zoo) and will be led by myself and Miss French. Two other Science teachers will also be accompanying us.

If you are interested in your son or daughter participating, please fill in the attached consent form with full medical information and dietary requirements included. Please return the consent form to the Finance Office and ensure payment via Parentpay is made by Monday 11 February 2019. It is important to note that should the payment deadline be missed, your son or daughter's place on the trip may be in jeopardy.
