Re: UCL Spectroscopy Day 2019, Tuesday 18 June 2019

As the day approaches I wanted to confirm the details of the event.

Students will be attending the UCL chemistry department and will take part in a number of activities organised as part of the trip to help in their studies. Students will be expected to behave responsibly in line with the St Martin's behaviour policy.

The university have provided the following itinerary for the day:

From 9.30am	Schools arrive (Nyholm room)
10.00am – 10.15am	Introduction and Welcome (chemistry lecture theatre)
10.15am – 12.00pm	Morning session: either Spectroscopy Lecture and Workshop (Ramsay lecture theatre) or Practical Spectroscopy Demonstrations
12.00pm – 12.45pm	Lunch (Nyholm room)
12.45pm – 2.30pm	Afternoon session, as morning session, with groups reversed
2.30pm – 3.15pm	Chemical demonstration (chemistry auditorium)
3.15pm	Day ends

Students are expected to make their own way to UCL and back home, I recommend that they travel by train then tube. The closest tube station to the venue is Euston Square (a four minute walk), students need to be there before 9.30am. Mrs Corbett and I will meet them outside of the chemistry department on Gordon Street (Christopher Ingold Building).

Students should bring lunch with them which can be eaten at the university or, weather permitting, the nearby park.

At the end of the day we will escort students back to Euston Square tube station, where at this point they are responsible for making their own way home.

I will provide all students with a map and emergency contact number before the day.
