Please note - about the BYMT Audition

We audition over 1,500 young people across the UK and Ireland every year, between October and February. There are approximately 280 places available in BYMT's theatre company, which produces 8 new shows each summer. Final casting decisions are made in the last week of February. Pupils that attend one of our school auditions will be contacted **within 3 weeks of their Audition Day** with a basic offer. We will then inform people at the beginning of March, which show they have been cast for that year's Summer Season. Those that don't receive an offer, may join our **reserves list** or be offered a place one of our **summer theatre training camps**.
