**Re: *Drama trip to Stratford-upon-Avon, July 2020***

I am writing to update you on our scheduled trip to Stratford-upon-Avon from 8 to 9 July. Currently, we are unable to tell you when we will be returning to school and when theatres will reopen. However, both the school and the RSC are optimistic that we may return with some form of normality next half term. If this is the case then our Stratford Upon Avon trip will go ahead as planned.

However, due to theatre closures, one of the performances we were scheduled to see has been cancelled. The RSC have offered the school a credit note to see another performance on another date. Therefore, we have organised for the Year 12 drama students to return to Stratford-upon-Avon on 17 September along with our Year 11 drama cohort to watch Shakespeare's *Comedy of Errors* at the Royal Shakespeare Theatre. There will be no extra cost and they will be able to travel by coach with Year 11.

It is important for drama and theatre students to see as much theatre as possible and this also ensures that the students still have a choice of both RSC plays for their Component 3 written exam.
