Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Year 10 Phased Return

As mentioned in Mr Smyrk's letter dated 2 June 2020, we are writing to inform you about the details of our phased return for all Year 10 students this term.

We are inviting 25% of the year group in at a time, which follows strict government guidelines. Three tutor groups, which make up a quarter of the year group have the opportunity to attend three core subject lessons. To make the organisation easier, we are dividing the year group into their four houses. Each student will come to school on five separate occasions over four weeks.

The new start time will be 9.30am and school will finish at 12.30pm. Please ensure that your child arrives before 9.30am and goes straight to the south hall. Social distancing will be observed at all times. The dates for each student to attend school is below:

Please be aware that the following arrangements have been made to put your mind at rest.

- Each house will be split into six classes, with no more than 12 students per group
- Each student will have their own classroom and own spaced out desk for all three lessons
- Deep cleans will occur in every classroom used, every afternoon ready for the following day
- Lessons will last for 45 minutes with a 15 minute break between each lesson
- We have chosen six large classrooms which have excellent ventilation

- Students will be asked to bring their own English, maths and science exercise books, writing equipment and a calculator
- Students will need to use their phones to capture key information as no handouts are allowed
- No catering facilities will be open on site so students need to bring their own food and drink which will be eaten outside
- Separate toilets and break areas will be used by each group of students
- Hand sanitisers will be used before entry to classrooms and again as students leave classrooms
- There are no school buses running during this time so students will need to make their own way to and from school. Please note, if they use public transport then a face mask must be worn
- Students will have the opportunity to meet their form tutor and pastoral team
- School uniform is not required

Please insist that your child travels directly to and from school as we need to be mindful of community transmission. Obviously, if your child or any of your family are showing COVID-19 symptoms, then you will need to follow government advice and stay at home for 14 days.

We are assuming that all Year 10 students will attend unless we hear otherwise. Please inform the Year 10 Administrator, Mrs Hunt, if you are not planning to send your child into school for any reason.

If the government advice changes again, then we will of course keep you updated and we are all looking forward to welcoming Year 10 students back into school.
