Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Covid-19 update - returning to the sixth form in September

Further to the letter sent by Mr Smyrk yesterday detailing information about measures being put in place in and around the school to ensure it is as normal and safe as possible, I am writing to inform you of a couple of additional measures being put in place in the sixth form block.

Firstly, students will receive by email a floor plan of the ground floor of the sixth form block. The plan details which entrances and exits are in use for both Year 12 and 13 and which they should not be using. Please ensure you read through this with your child so they know the new movement systems within the sixth form block.

Secondly, the common room will be the Year 12 designated area. However, due to the Bistro being in the common room, Year 13 will need to access the common room for short periods of time whilst they purchase food. It will be a requirement for Year 13 students entering the common room to wear face coverings whilst in this area which can then be removed if they wish once they return to their own designated area.

Whilst I realise that these measures may make things feel different for a while, it is important that we do all we can to ensure a safe environment for all our students and staff.

I look forward to welcoming back all students next week.
