Dear Parents or Carers

Re: Sixth Form students and the new security fencing

I am writing to you to give some more information on the implications of the new security fencing for sixth form students. Once the fencing is erected, students will be more limited on the times they will be able to exit the school site as the gates will be locked for the majority of the school day.

Students will still be able to leave site at the start of break and the start of lunch; the gates will remain open at these times for approximately ten minutes. Students that finish after P1 or P3 will need to be prepared to use the following period to study and complete independent work as they will not be able to leave school site at this time.

Year 13 students that have a parking permit will still be able to park in south car park but will be required to park in front of the security fencing, in the main body of the car park rather than behind the boy's gym. Students will need to leave school site via north drive at the designated times and walk across to the south entrance to collect their cars when leaving for the day.

I realise this may influence students' current leaving times but I am sure that you will agree that the addition of the fencing will significantly improve the safeguarding provision at the school.
